Please be advised that the 10% penalty will be reinstated for utility bills not paid by the due date starting September 2020.

The minimum tax was first announced in our May community newsletter. However, we realize there were some communications issues associated with it since then. 
We have a website, Facebook page, and monthly newsletter. And our monthly utility bills can be used to convey information. We will discuss how the Village uses these tools.
