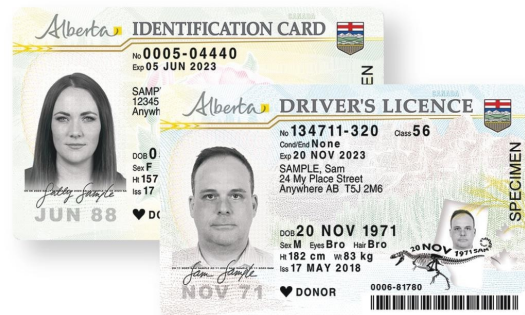
### Authorized Identification

- 2** Show *two pieces of identification*, both with your name and with one piece showing your current physical address, from the list below:

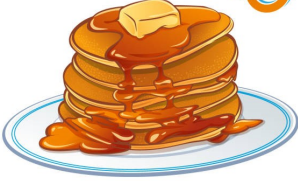
